



Restriction or Embargo on the release of your thesis contents

The intention of the Toronto School of Theology, its member colleges and the University of Toronto is that there should be no restriction on the distribution and publication of theses. However, in exceptional cases, the author, in consultation with the thesis director and with the approval of the TST Graduate Centre for Theological Studies Director, shall have the right to postpone public access for a period of up to two years from the date of acceptance of the thesis. These reasons shall be stated in a separate letter to the TST GCTS Director.

For the duration of the authorized restriction period, the abstract only – not the body of the thesis – will be available via T-Space, and Library and Archives Canada.

Restricting the release date requires original signatures of both the author and the TST GCTS Director. The original of this form must be submitted to the TST GCTS Office.
