Candidacy must be achieved by the end of the third year for all doctoral programs. In exceptional circumstances, a student who has not met these requirements may be permitted to register in the program for up to 12 months at the discretion of the GCTS Coordinator. Continuation beyond 12 months will require the approval of both the college AD Director and the GCTS Executive.

To apply for an extension, the student must present the causes for the delay and evidence that the remaining requirements will be completed within the period of the extension requested.
