3. Candidates should have the ability to identify and carry out a research project.
4. Consider the candidate's intellectual abilities and achievements, as well as their abilities and achievements in the practice of ministry.
5. Consider the Candidate's personal qualities, including a sense of vocation, leadership, family and community life.
6. Include your assessment of the candidate's suitability for admission to the DMin program and your assessment of his or her ability to complete the programme (approximately 4 yrs.) while continuing in their practice of ministry.
