# SSHRC and OGS APPLICATION GUIDE 2014-2015 Awards

## General tips...

- Read the information carefully. Pay close attention to **eligibility** rules.
- Pay attention to how your application looks.
- When writing your OGS plan of study or statement of interest and/or your SSHRC program of work, remember that the applications are reviewed and adjudicated by multidisciplinary committees. You must be able to convey your message to a general audience, not just people in your specific field. Test it out on friends, family, and fellow students and ask for feedback.
- Pay attention to spelling, grammar, and style. Be clear and concise. Proofread.
- Pay close attention to the OGS and SSHRC guidelines on what is expected in your plan or program. Read the websites – there are tips and hints for writing applications.
- Be sure to comply to font and margin specifications, as well as length limits.
- Your references are very important. Spend time with your referees and show them your plan of study or program of work. Ask for feedback. Provide them with the proper forms and the guidelines on what is required. Forms and guidelines are available on the websites. Be clear about deadlines and follow up!
- Neither SSHRC nor OGS will consider your application if it is incomplete.

## **SSHRC** – MA and ThD/PhD students only

## **DEADLINES** – submit to the TST AD office by:

ThD/PhD	October 21, 2013
MA	December 1, 2013 (postmarked)
	November 29, 2013 if delivered in person

TST will not accept late or incomplete applications.

## **Eligibility:**

- MA and ThD/PhD students are eligible for SSHRC.
- International/Visa students are not eligible for SSHRC.

#### **SSHRC Notes continued:**

- Prepare your application(s) online, but submit a printed version to the AD office along with any supporting documentation. VERIFY your application before printing. "Please verify" should not appear on your copy.
- Original transcripts must be requested from the issuing institution a minimum of 2 weeks in advance and sent by the institution directly to the TST AD Office. Request transcripts from all previous academic institutions, including from your current TST College. For international studies, you may request a certified copy of the original from your TST College Registrar.
- SSHRC Letters of Appraisal should be sent by your referees directly to the TST AD
  office, using the electronic, fillable pdf forms on SSHRC's website (use the forms link on
  the left hand side). Send the link to your referee.
- The Departmental Appraisals will be made by the Advanced Degree Director of TST after the Ranking Committee has met do not include with your submission.

## **OGS** – ThM and ThD students only

## **DEADLINES** – submit online by:

Domestic ThD and ThM	March 3, 2014
International/Visa ThD and ThM	March 3, 2014

The application form will be available on the U of T SGS website in mid-October, 2013

### **OGS Eligibility:**

- F/T students in ThM and ThD programs with at least an A- average are eligible for OGS.
- Domestic and International/Visa students are eligible for OGS.

- All material, including the reference letters, is submitted online. No paper forms.
- The **Plan of study** (approx. 500 words) is submitted online.
- The Academic background is submitted online. Paper/hard copies of transcripts are not required. Each student is responsible for uploading copies of their transcripts or academic history online. Transcripts should be combined into 1 file for upload as multiple files may cause delays.
- Academic references are submitted online by the referee/faculty member. After you've input their name and contact information, an email is sent to the faculty member with a link to their online reference letter submission page.
