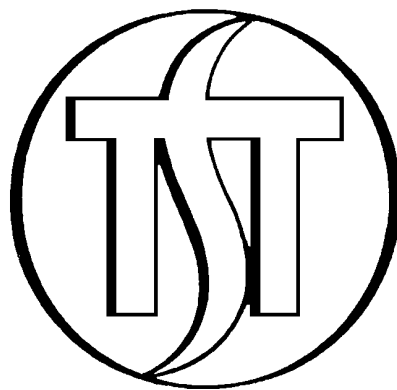

## **EXPLANATION OF STATISTICS**

The following pages provide statistical information on the 2007-2008 TST enrolment. In some cases, we have also provided statistics from the previous five years to chart the trends in enrolment. Data were taken from the University of Toronto's student records database, ROSI (Repository for Student Information). This information is provided numerically as well as visually to show the breakdown of information. The tables and figures were prepared by Natasja VanderBerg, Coordinator of Academic Services and Registrar, TST. The tables and figures fall into one of four categories:

1. Teaching Activity (teaching contributions of colleges and departments and student registrations)
2. Enrolment (full-time equivalent and head count enrolment over the past five years)
3. Demographics of Students (age, gender, part time/full time status, domestic/international)
4. Admissions (broken down by program and geographic origin)

In previous years, we were able to include preliminary enrolment data for the year in which the report was presented based on September registrations. However, due to the new timing of the Annual General Meeting, September registration data is not yet available and thus we are unable to provide projections for 2008-2009. We are able, at this time, to provide Summer 2008 data, which is available on the next page.

### **TEACHING ACTIVITY:** (Table 1, 1A & 1B, Figures 1-4)

- Table 1 on "Teaching Activity by Departments and Colleges" reports how many course registrations occurred in the courses offered by colleges and departments. Tables 1A and 1B are included for the first time this year, and provide detailed information about teaching and cross-registrations.
- Figures 1 and 2 present trends over the last five years in the teaching contributions of the member colleges. Figure 3 presents the relative teaching contribution of departments shown by course registrations (Biblical, Historical, Pastoral, Theological, Field Education and Doctor of Ministry).
- Figure 4 is new this year. It shows the percentage of courses taken by students that are offered within their home college, within their broader tradition, and outside of their broader tradition.

### **ENROLMENT:** (Tables 2-4, Figures 5-8)

- Table 2 presents a detailed view of FTE (Full-Time Equivalent) student enrolment by TST college. The terms eligible and ineligible refer to whether or not the student's registration generates entitlement for government funding.
- Table 2A presents the same data as Table 2, except that it shows the BIU ("Basic Income Unit") count, reflecting the greater weight for ThD and ThM for deriving government funding for eligible students.
- Table 3 presents the same enrolment as Table 2, except that it shows enrolment by head count rather than FTE.
- Table 4, Analysis of 2007-2008 Enrolment Data, shows student registrations by college and program.
- Figure 5 provides an overall picture of enrolment in TST over the past five years.
- Figures 6, 7 and 8 report on FTE enrolment patterns by college over the past five years, for Advanced Degree (Figure 6), Basic Degree (Figure 7) and all programs (Figure 8).

### **DEMOGRAPHICS OF STUDENTS:** (Figures 9-12)

- Figure 9 shows the average age of students in each program of study in the current year.
- Figure 10 shows the percentage of female and male students at the basic degree and advanced degree levels over the last five years.
- Figure 11 shows the percentage of part-time and full-time students at the basic degree and advanced degree levels over the past five years.
- Figure 12, included in the Enrolment Report for the first time this year, shows the proportion of domestic students vs. international students, and shows the country of citizenship of the current international students.

### **ADMISSIONS:** (Figure 13 & 14)

- Figure 13 shows the head count for admissions into each program over the past five years.

- Figure 14 is a new figure. It shows the geographical origin of the students admitted into programs in 2007.

## CONVOICATIONS

Regis College, St. Michael's College and St. Augustine's Seminary held graduation ceremonies in November 2007. Emmanuel College, Knox College, Trinity College and Wycliffe College held graduation ceremonies in May 2008. Degrees were awarded as follows:

Of the 6 PhDs awarded, 2 were conferred on students of Emmanuel, 1 conferred on a student of Regis, 1 St. Michael's, 1 Trinity and 1 Wycliffe.

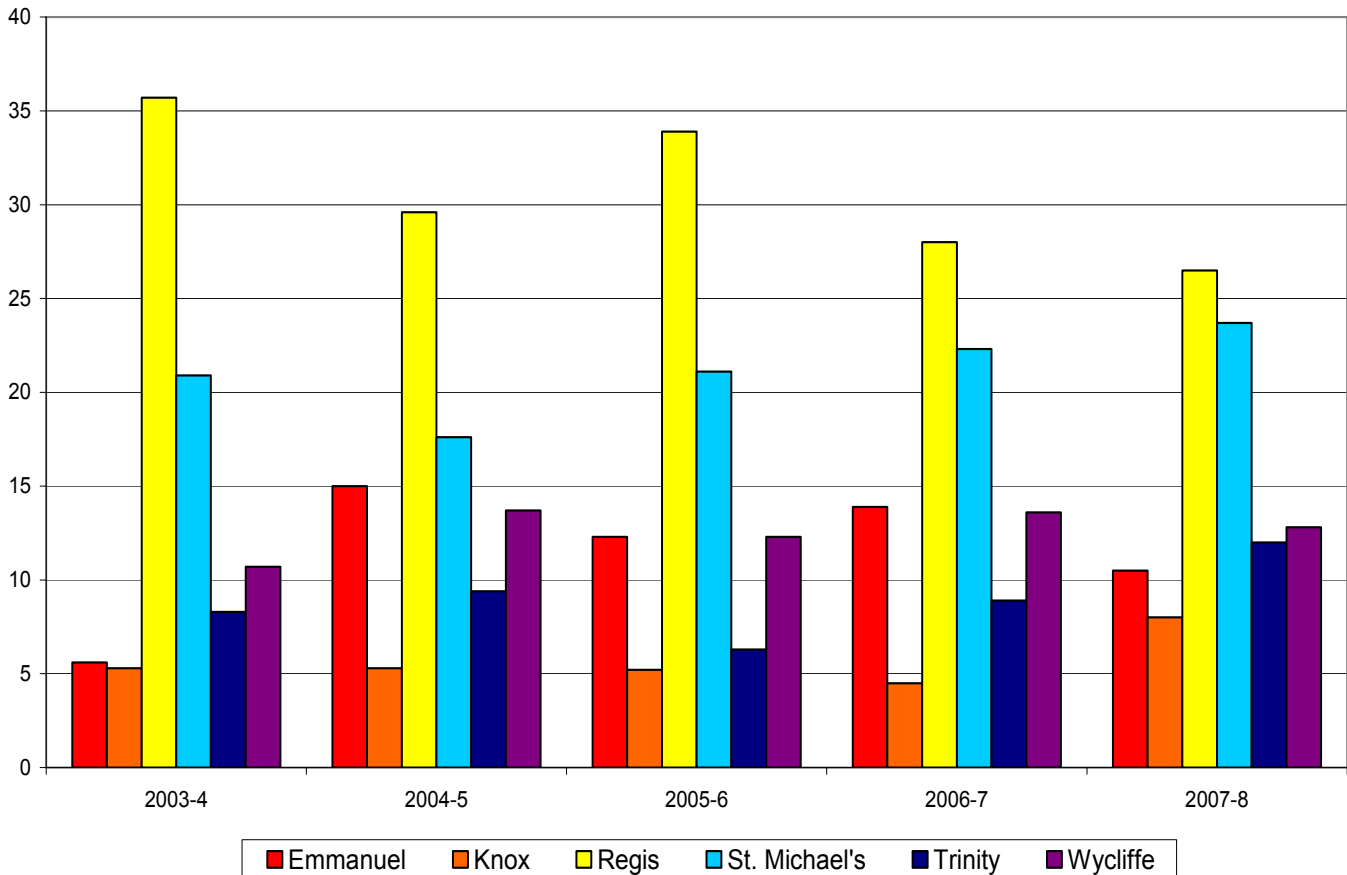

**Trend from 2006 - 2007 to 2007 - 2008:** The total head count in 2006-2007 was 1631. Total enrolment: decrease of 6.1%; 4.25% in Basic Degree enrolment and 6.84% in Advanced Degree enrolment. Enrolment in the ThD program increased by 4.7% (192 from 201) while the enrolment in the PhD remained unchanged from 2006-2007. The DMin program experienced the greatest increase in enrolment: 43% from 30 students in 2006-2007 to 43 students in 2007-2008. The other Advanced Degrees as well as all of the Basic Degrees experienced slight decreases in enrolment numbers.

Advanced Degree**

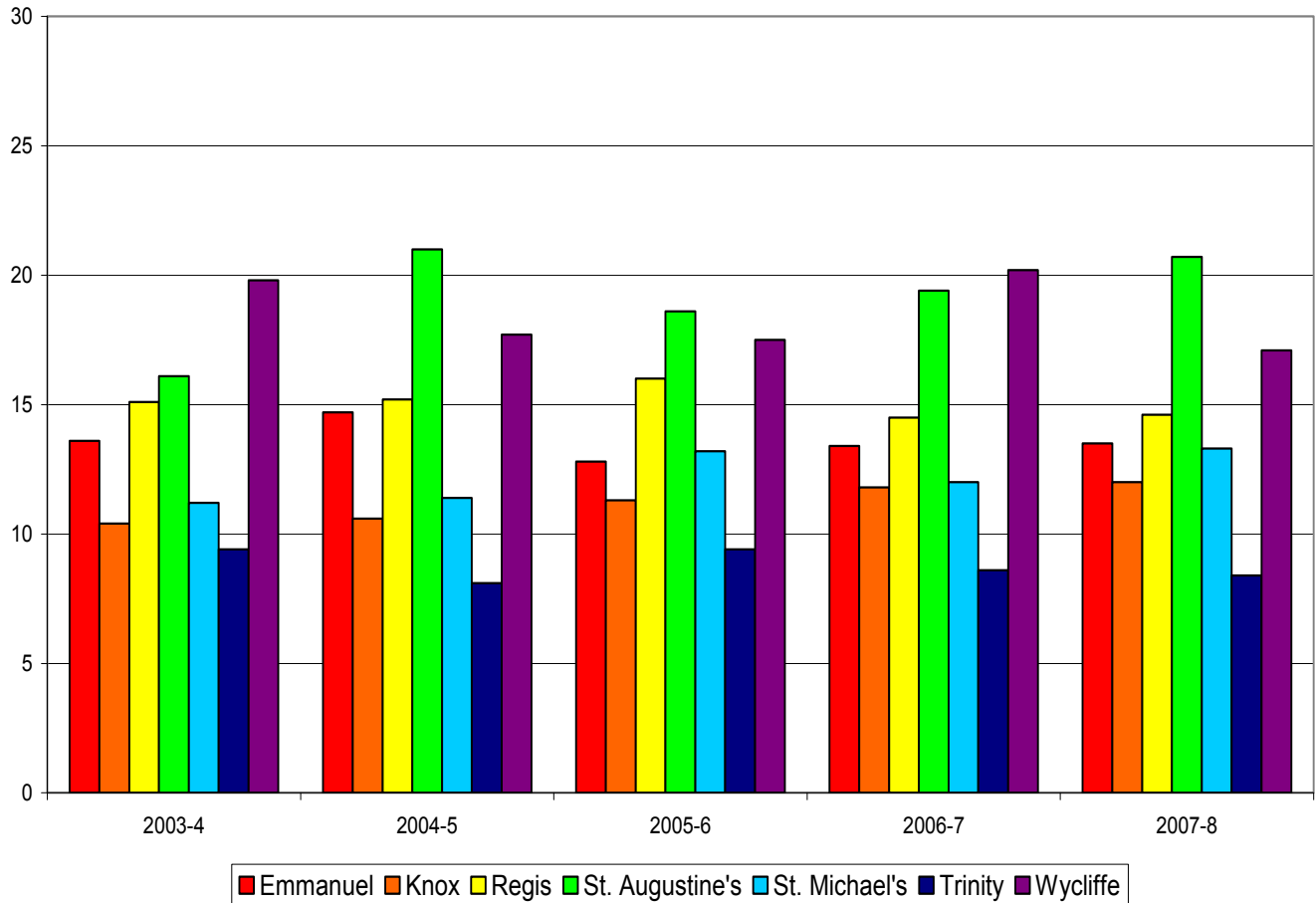

Basic Degree**

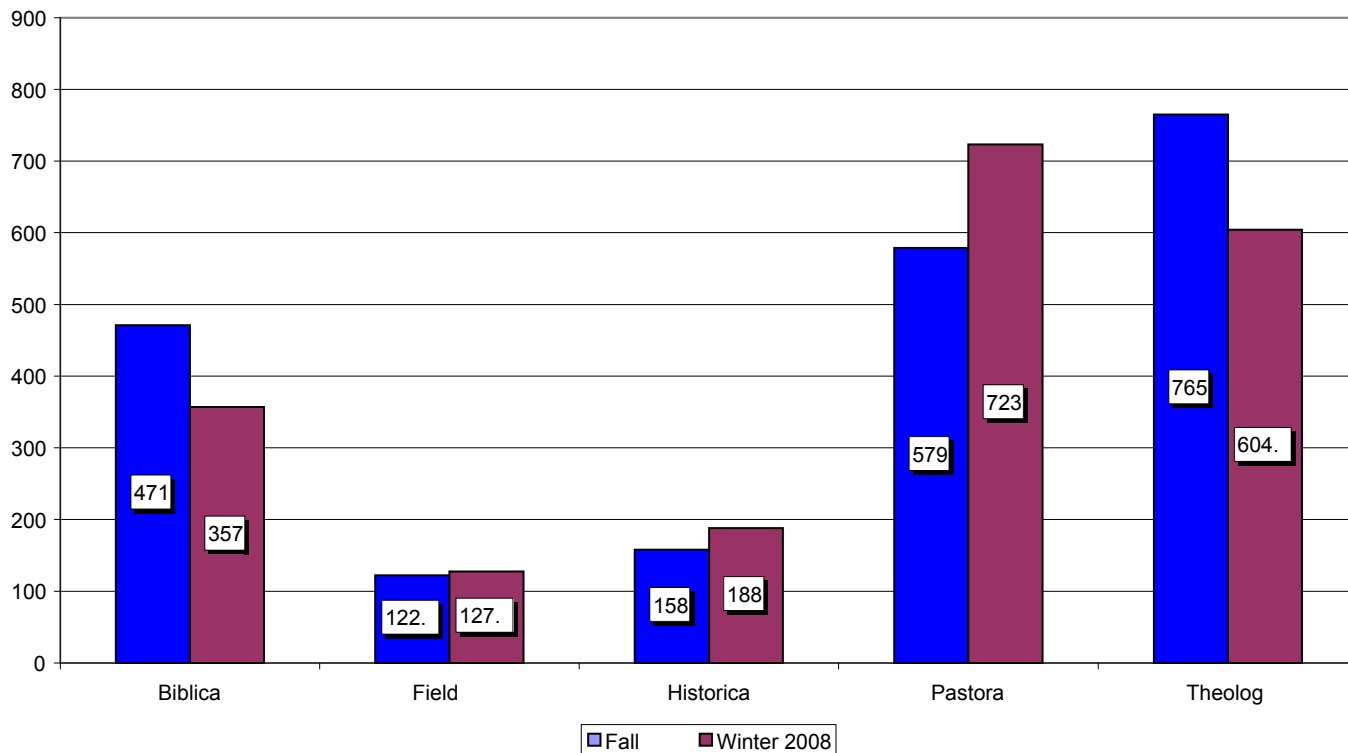

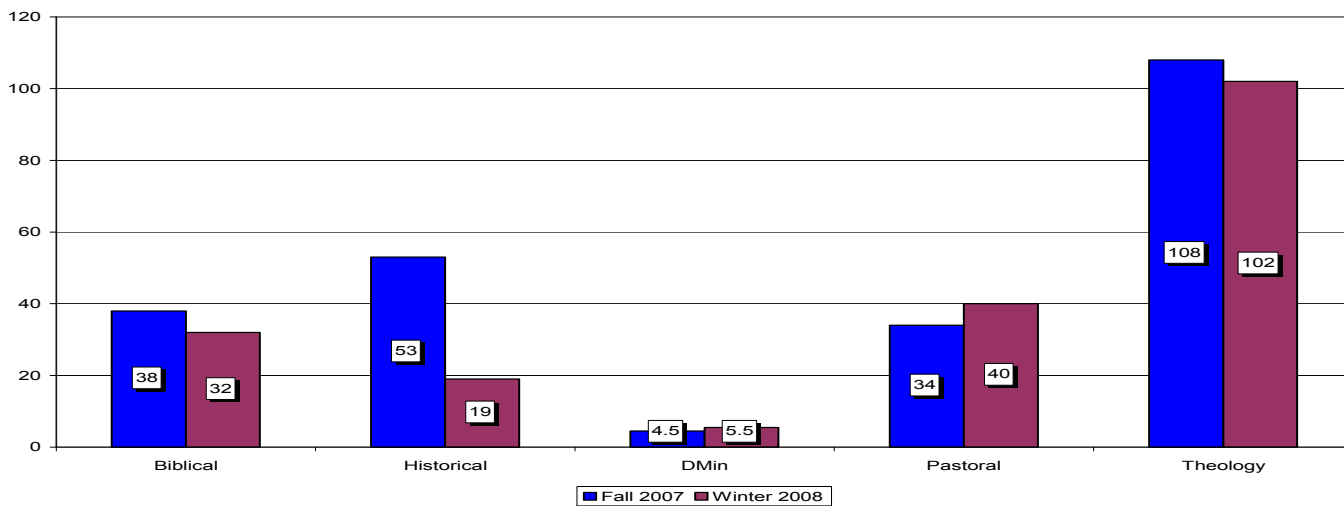

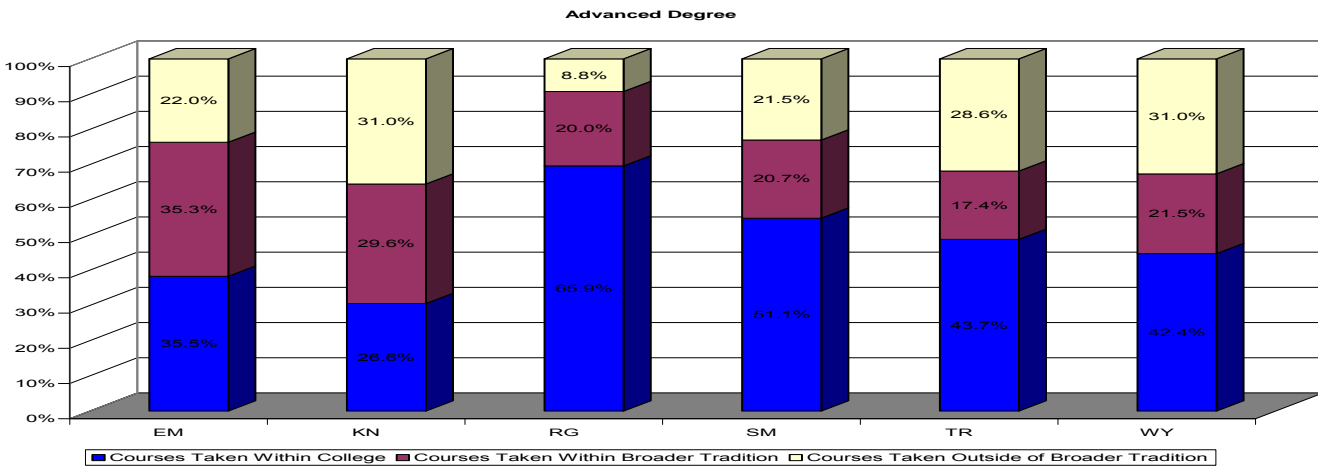
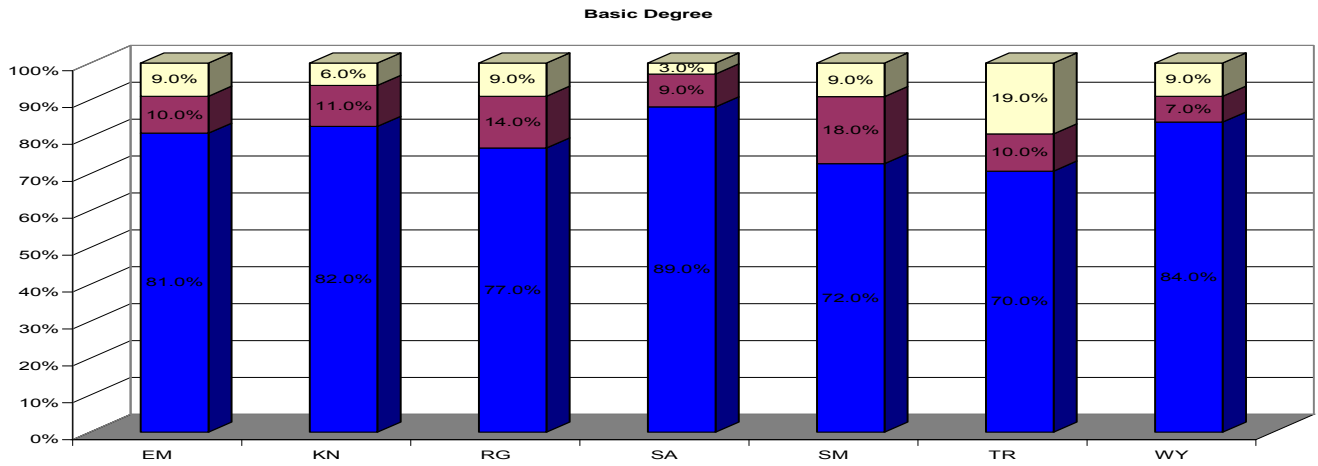

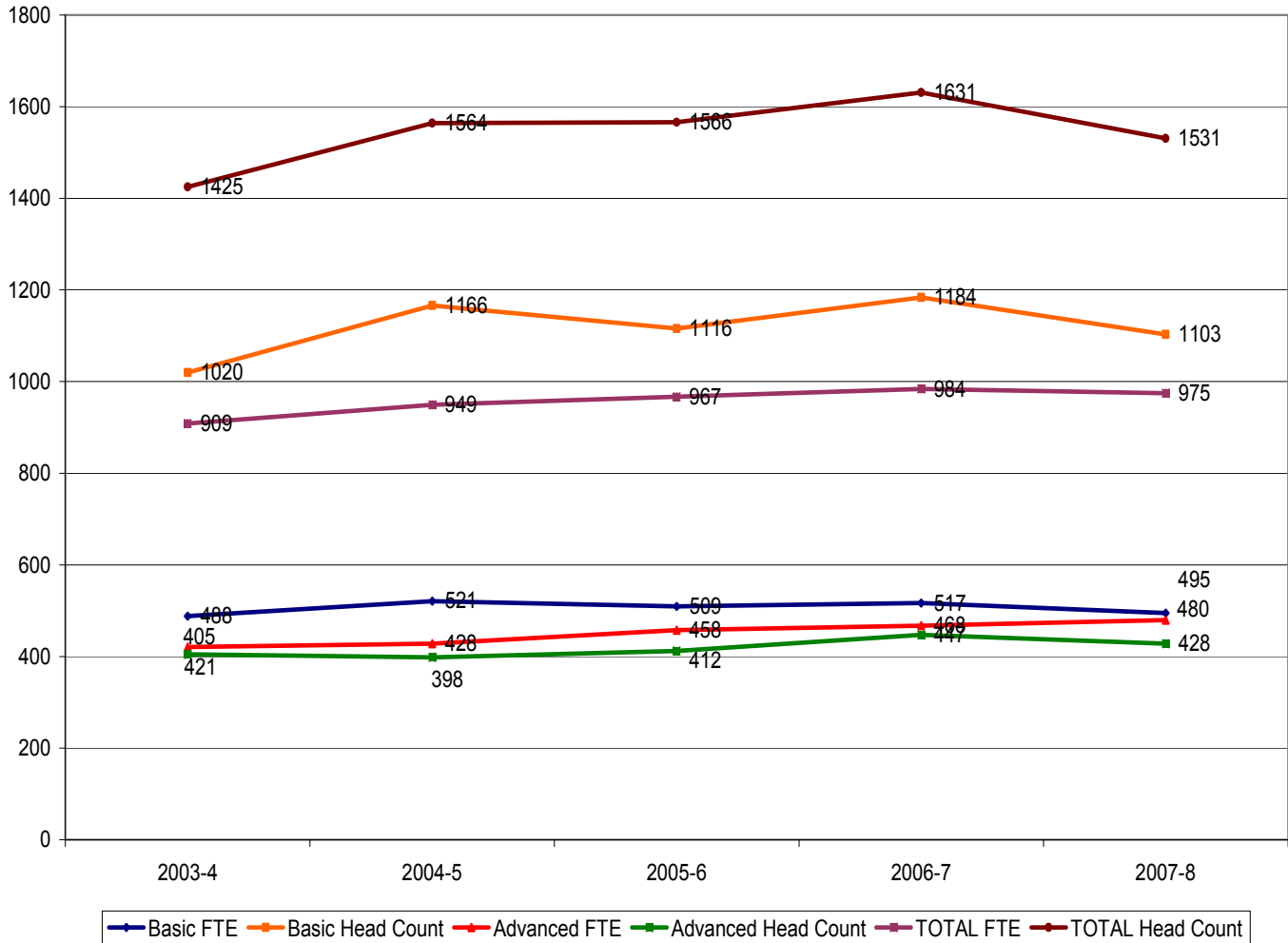

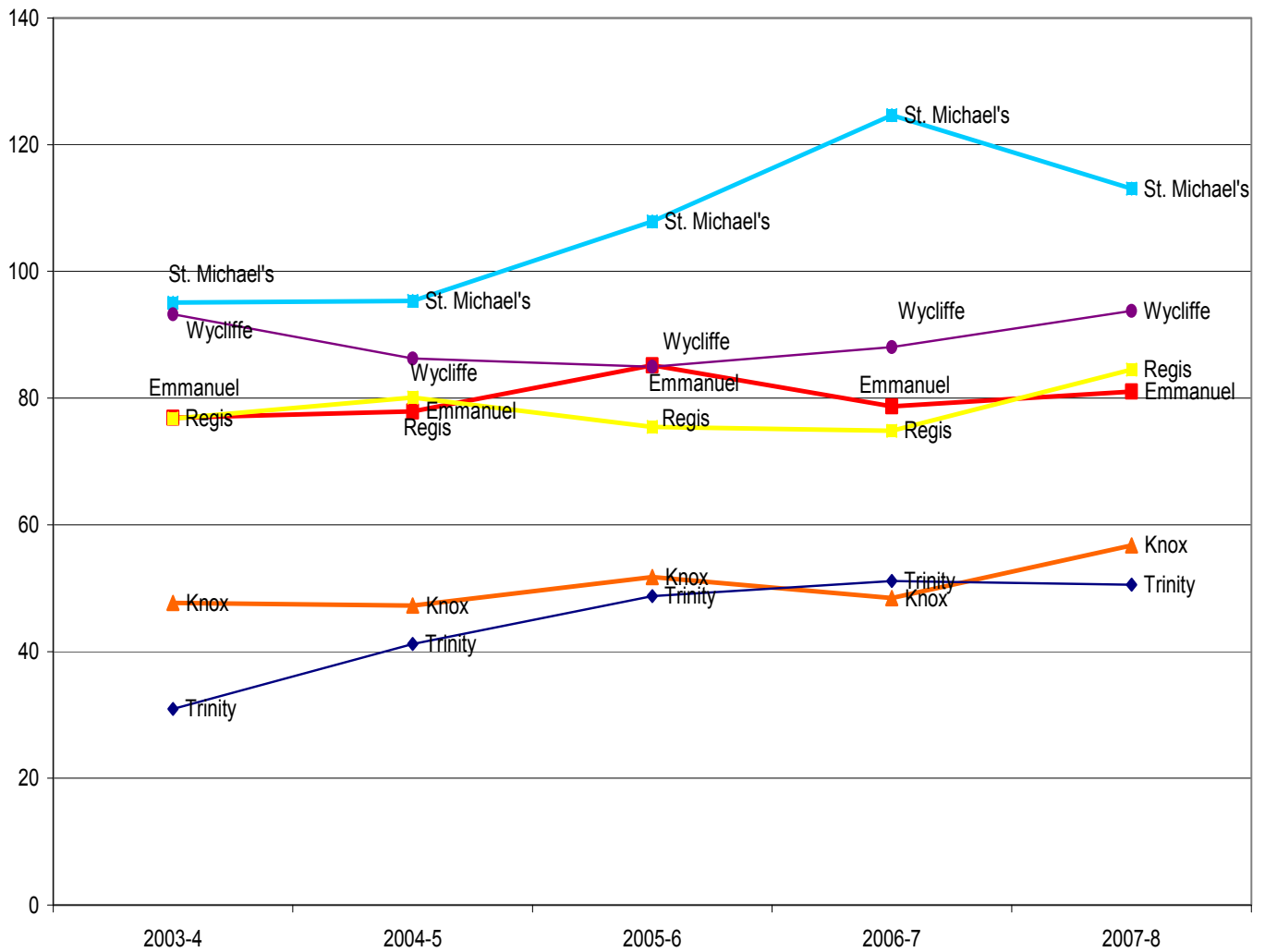
**Total TST Enrolment: Last Five Years**

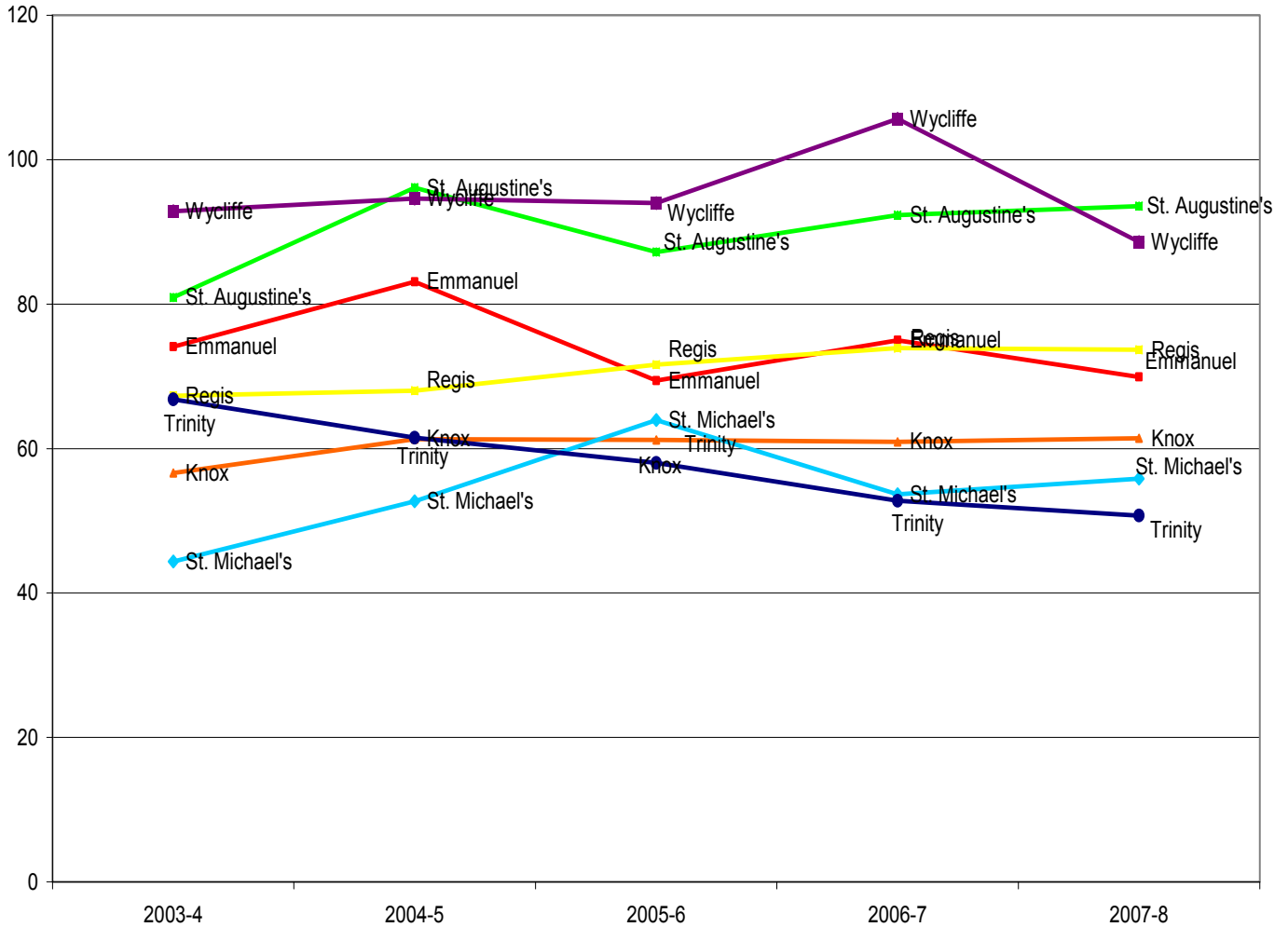
**FTE Enrolment: Last Five Years Advanced Degree**

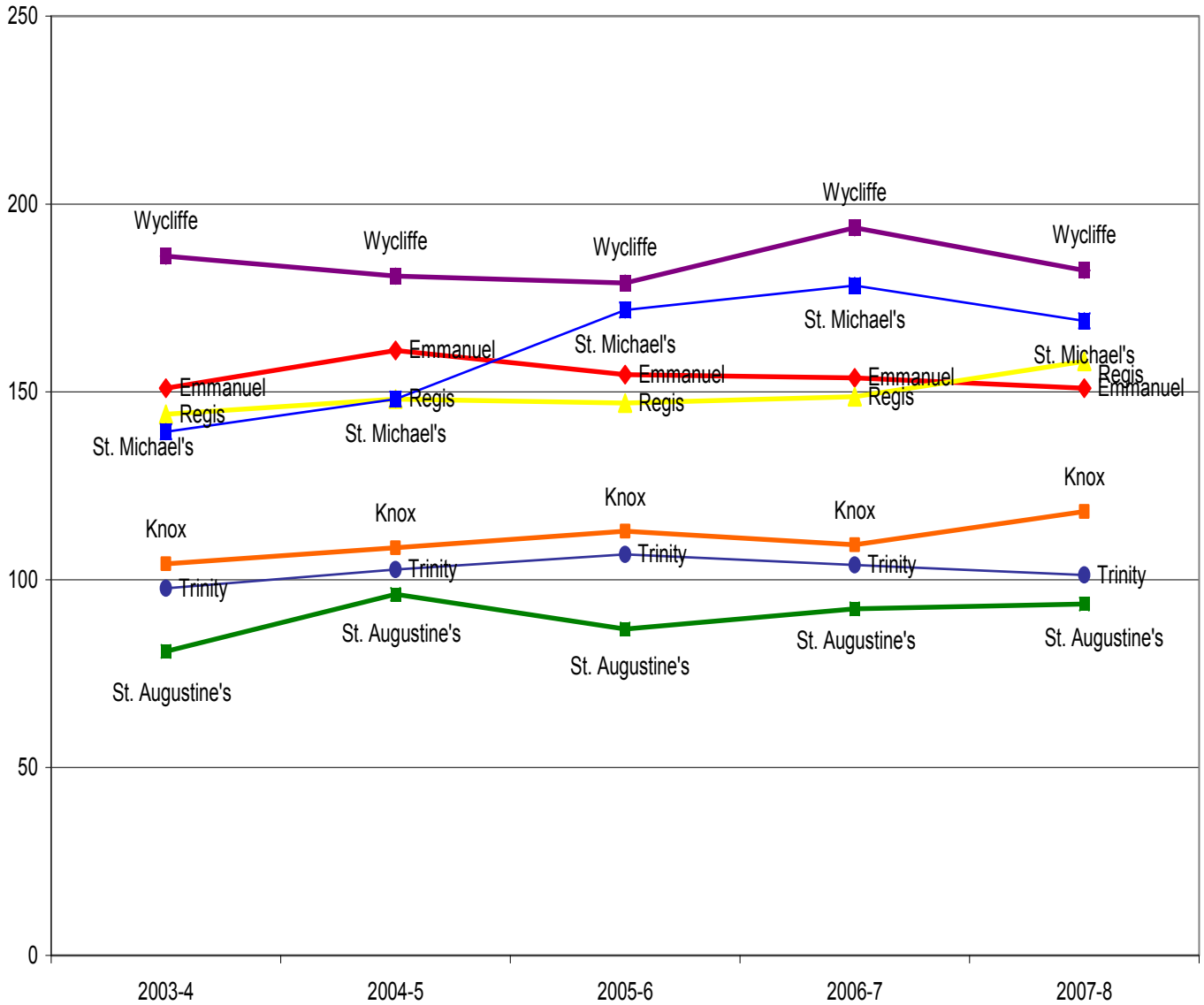
**FTE Enrolment: Last Five Years Basic Degree**

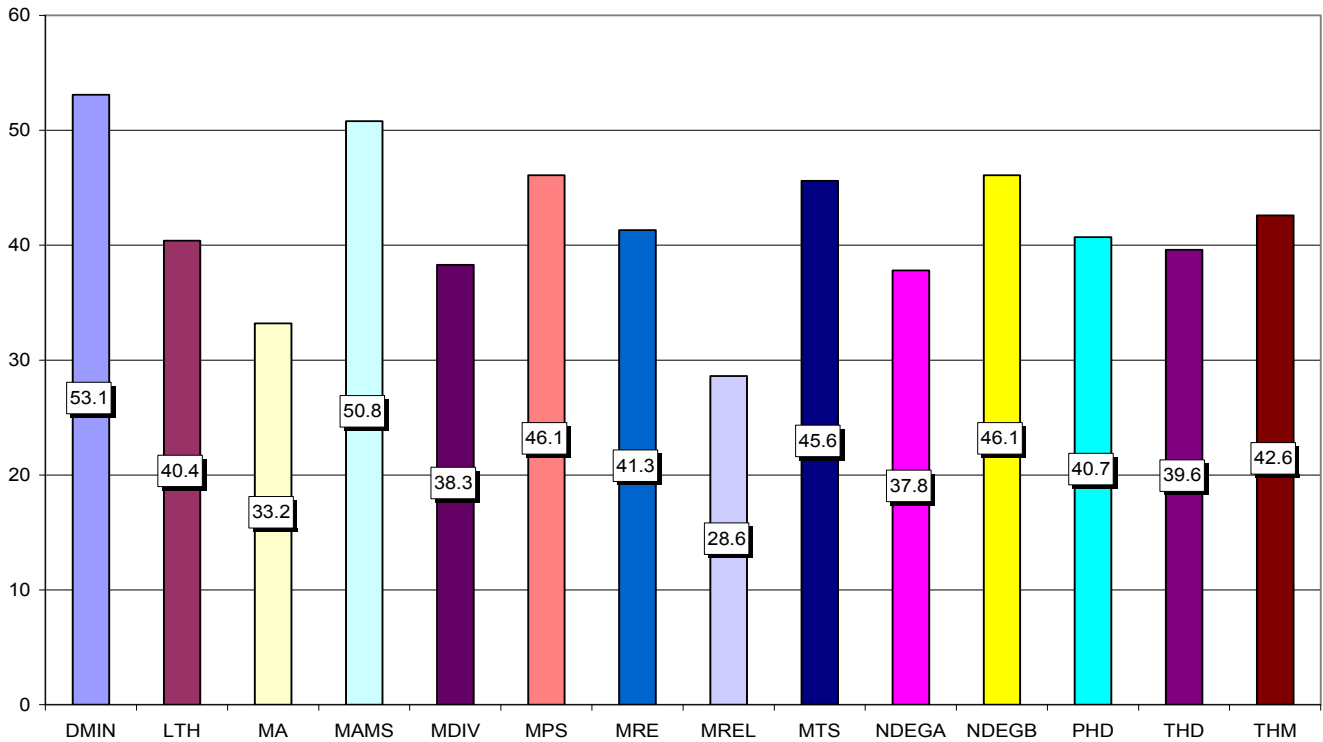
**FTE ENROLMENT: Last Five Years Total (Basic & Advanced)**

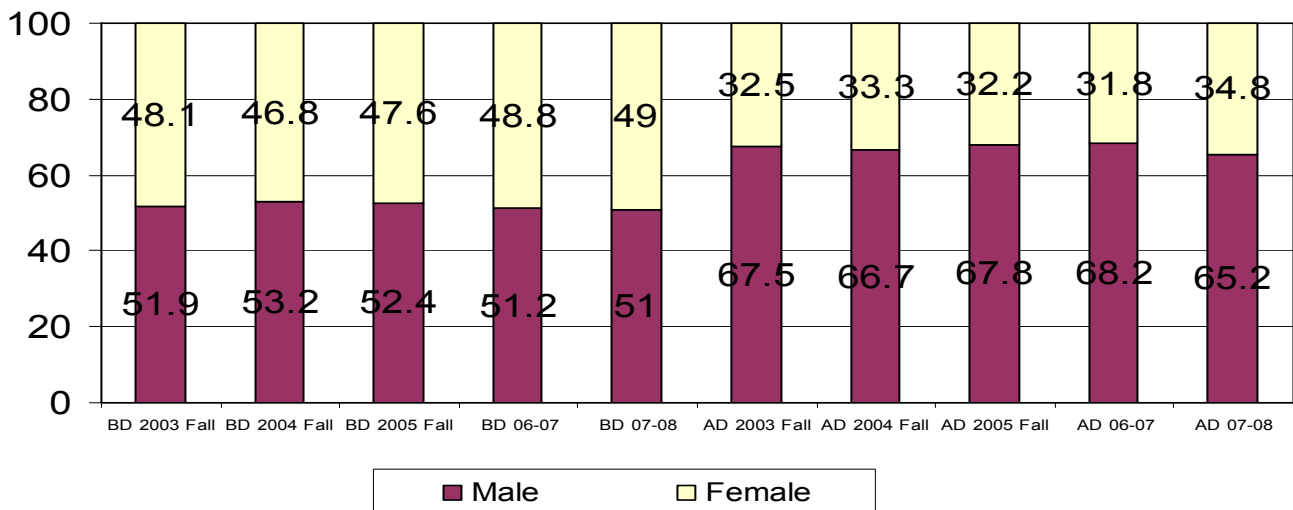

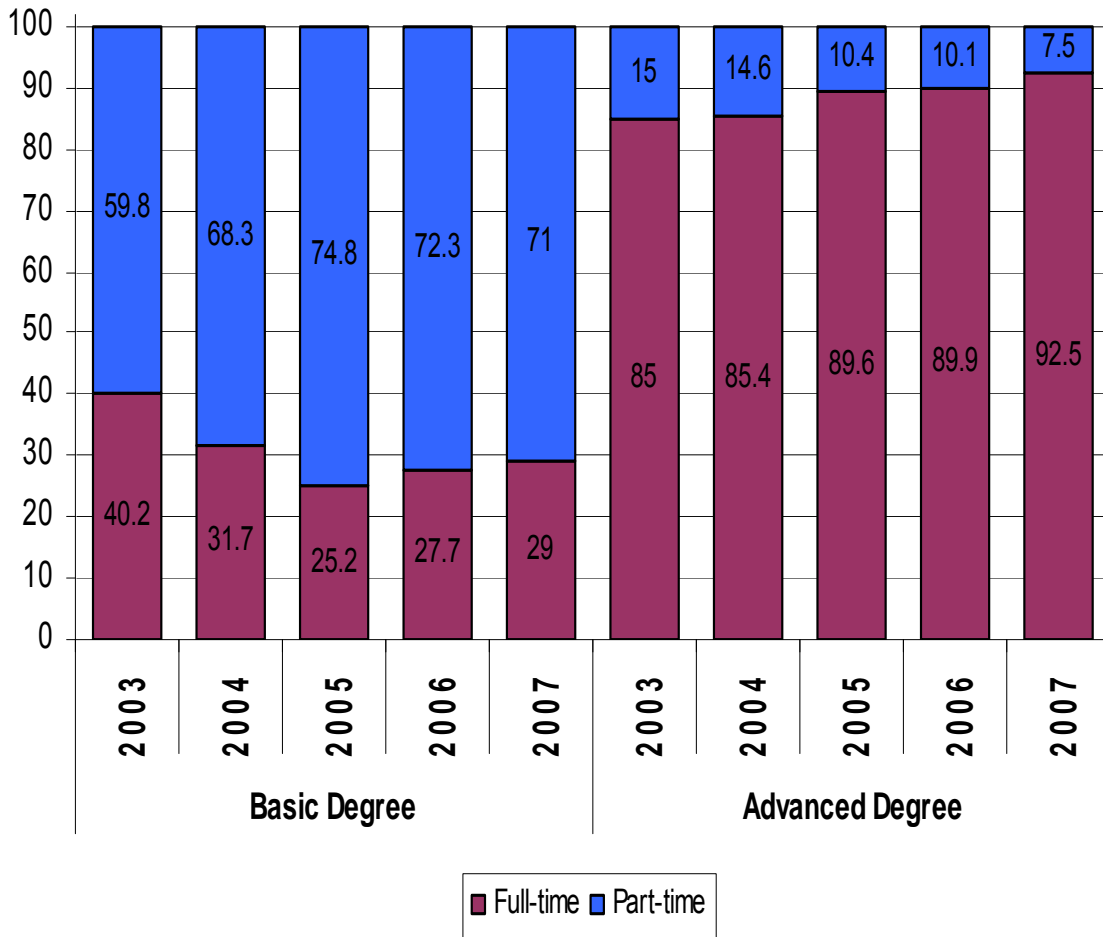
**Gender over the Last Five Years (Percentage)**

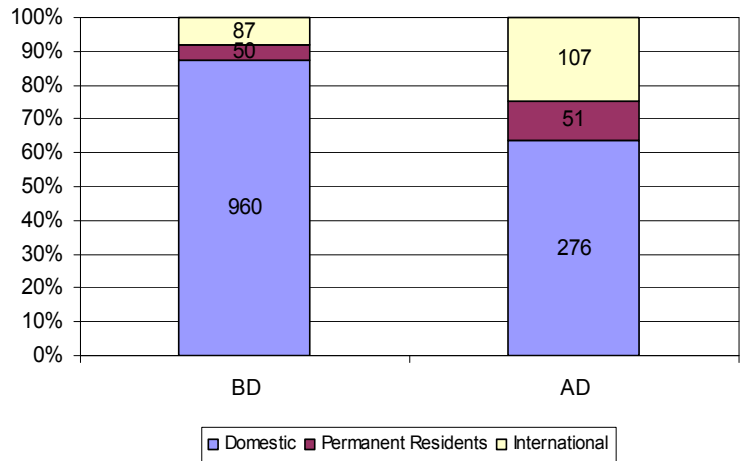
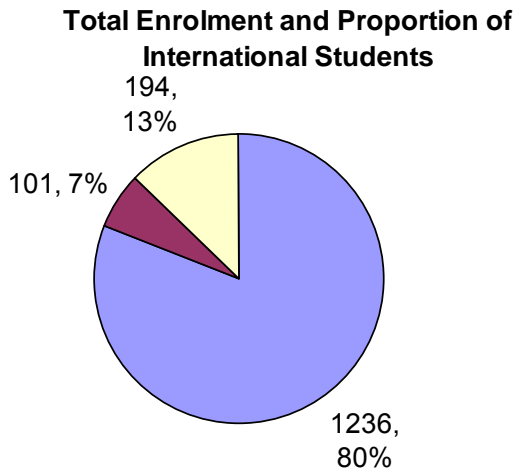
**Attendance Classification by Percentage over the Last Five Years**



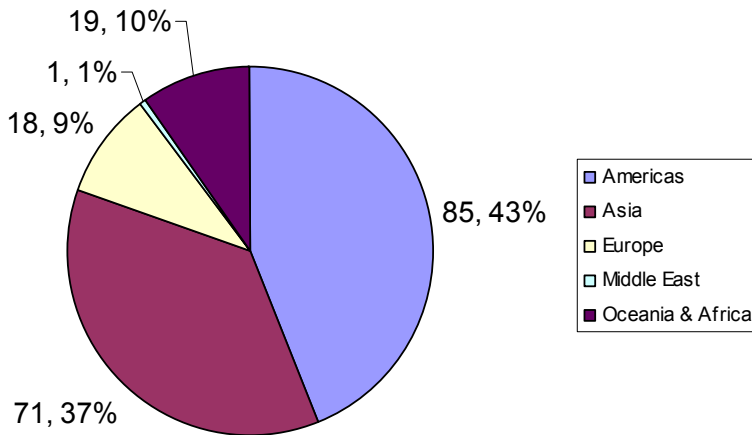

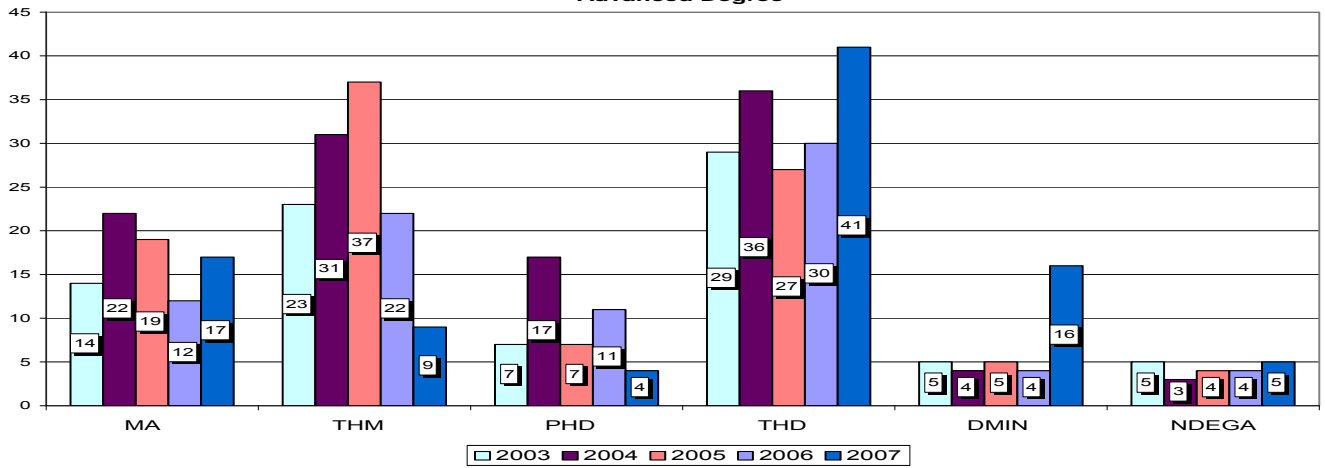

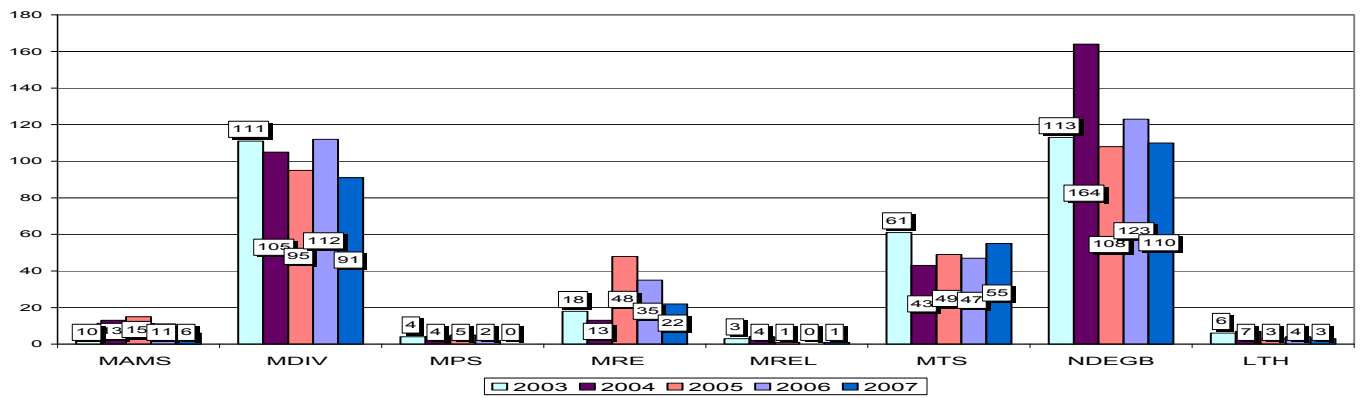

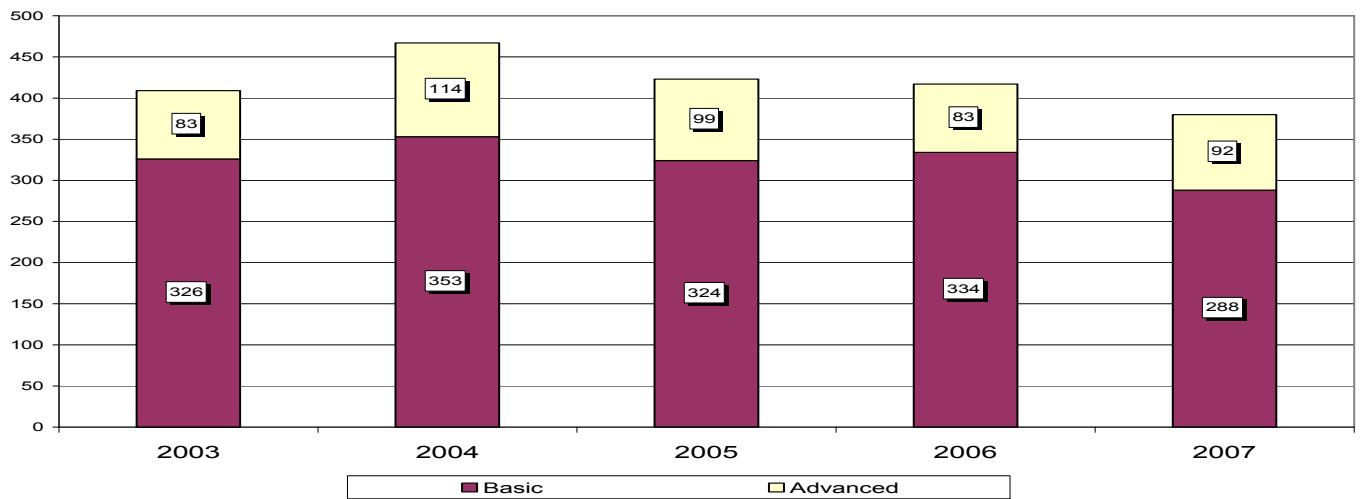
**ADMISSIONS BY PROGRAM**

**Admissions - Total (Basic Degree and Advanced Degree)**

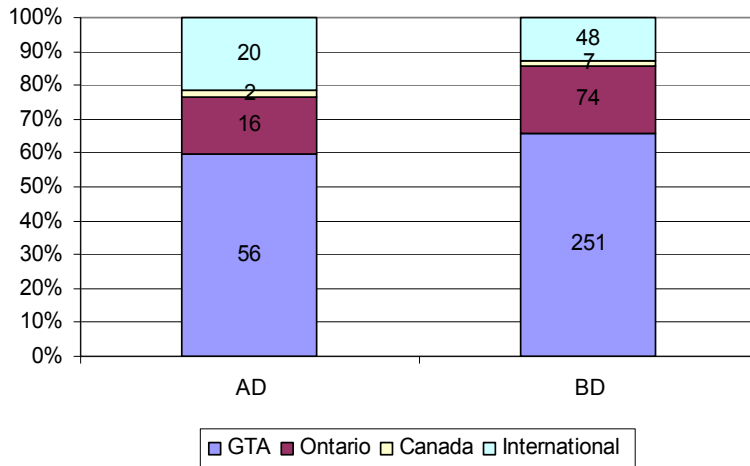
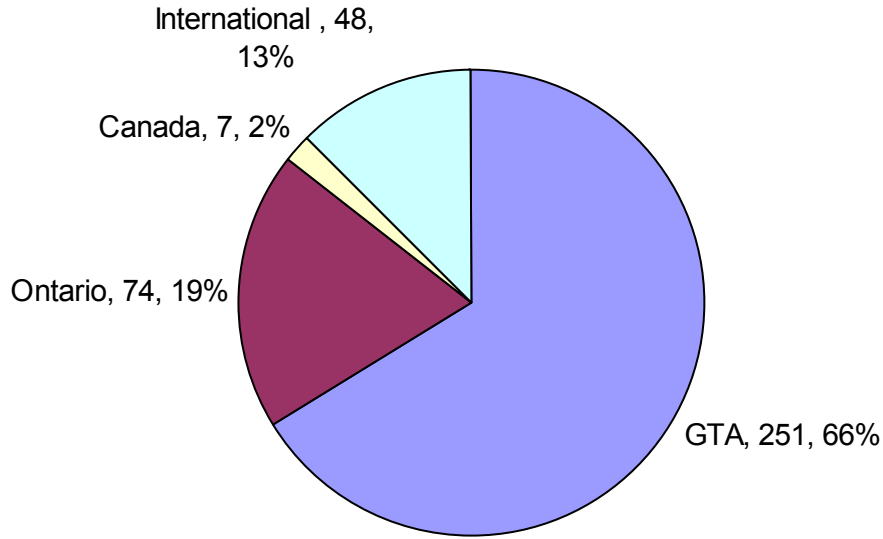
