The eligibility criteria for awards with * includes being a Canadian citizen, permanent resident or Protected Person, **and** a resident of Ontario.

Donald Cameron Memorial Award

- Student in the final year of a basic degree program; or in the first year of a graduate degree program immediately following a basic degree program
- Recognizes excellence in projects planned and completed by students during their basic degree program, and which engaged them with the wider community beyond the Church.
- 2019 amount to be awarded: \$3,600

Gordon Farquharson Scholarship*

- Research doctoral program (ThD and PhD) student
- Academic excellence and demonstrated financial need
- 2019 Amount to be awarded: \$12,900

Margaret Fleck Scholarship*

- Graduate degree student
- Academic excellence and demonstrated financial need
- 2019 amount to be awarded: \$15,300

C. Douglas Jay Scholarship*

- Graduate degree student in Christian social ethics, philosophical theology, philosophy of religion or psychology of religion
- Academic excellence and demonstrated financial need
- 2019 amount to be awarded: \$18,800

Marjorie Watson Powles Award

- A student studying in a basic degree or graduate degree program
- Active engagement in community and congregational life with a strong feminist perspective and transformative vision, and demonstrated academic excellence
- 2019 amount to be awarded: \$2,400

Order of Saint Lazarus Bursary*

- Graduate degree student working in the area of ecumenism
- Academic excellence and demonstrated financial need
- 2019 amount to be awarded: \$2,100

OSOTF Bursary Assistance*

- PhD, ThD and DMin student
- Demonstrated financial need
- 2019 amount to be awarded: \$3,950 (this amount may be divided into multiple bursaries)
