Re: placements in summer, 2020, after July 6

We greatly appreciate the openness of the UHN hospitals and CPE supervisors of making placements available after July 6, 2020. However, students from the Toronto School of Theology may not take these CPE courses for academic credit.

Under COVID-19 Academic Continuity plans that have been registered with the University of Toronto, Toronto School of Theology (TST) received formal approval from the Provost of the University of Toronto for a formal program disruption until August 2020. This action allows our MPS and M Div students registered in CPE for the summer of 2020 to fulfill this degree requirement through a sequence of summer courses. Providing these courses fulfilled our obligation to students to allow them to advance on schedule in their degree programs. As a result, even though CPE practicums may now be partially available, we do not have confirmation of insurance for summer students, and we do not have these courses registered on our summer schedule. Therefore, students cannot take these courses for academic credit.
