

Procedural Changes to Membership of the Final Oral Examination Committee  
Effective September 2024

**C12.1 Members of the Final Oral Examination Committee**

The five (5) members of the Final Oral Examination committee (Board) are voting members. In addition, the FOE committee has one non-voting member: the Chair of the FOE, who is appointed by the GCTS, and presides over the entire process of the oral examination, i.e., the initial meeting of the examiners, the oral defence itself, and the final session of the examiners to decide upon the outcome of the defence. The Chair is responsible for ensuring that the candidate is treated fairly and that the proceedings follow approved regulations. The TST Executive Director, the Associate Director, Graduate Programs, or their representative, may also be present as a non-voting qualified observer.
